	AMEND AWARD OF BID TO INCLUDE SALES TAX FOR THE PURCHASE OF SERVICE WEAPON AMMUNITION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,066

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council take the following actions:

- 1) Amend the award of bid to include sales tax;
- 2) Bid award for the purchase of service weapon ammunition to both Dooley Enterprises and All State Police Equipment;

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Action of this item will approve an amendment to the original award of bid for the purchase of service weapon ammunition to include sales tax, which was not included in the original award approval.

FISCAL IMPACT: The additional cost for the sales tax for the purchases from both vendors is \$5,533 for FY 2018-19 and \$5,533 FY 2019-2020 for a total of \$11,066. The additional expenditures will be paid for from the Range Expense account line (101-2004-52440-00000) in the Training Bureau budget, which has sufficient funding.

PREVIOUS RELATED ACTION: The City Council approved a contract to Dooley Enterprises and All State Police Equipment for the purchase of service weapon ammunition on January 8, 2018.

DISCUSSION:

On January 8, 2018, the City Council approved an award of bid to Dooley Enterprises and All State Police Equipment for the purchase of service weapon ammunition. The originally approved amounts of \$19,796 to Dooley Enterprises and \$39,015 to All State Police Equipment did not include sales tax. Therefore, this amendment would include a total of \$11,066 in sales

tax for both purchases for the last two years of the term of the contract (FY 2018-19 and FY 2019-20).
