

RESOLUTION NO. 3721-A

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMONA, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA; APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT.

A. REQUEST:

1. APPLICATION FOR: Renewal to May 14, 1981 of Conditional Use Permit for Martin Iron and Metals
2. APPLICANT: Mr. Willis Boyd, Jr.
3. LOCATION: 1341 East Mission Boulevard, Pomona, CA

B. ACTION:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Commission as follows:

According to the procedure as set forth in Section .580, Ordinance 1466, the Planning Commission has heard this request for renewal of a Conditional Use Permit for Martin Iron and Metals and it is hereby found and determined that the metal salvage operation be allowed to continue for one year, during which time regular inspections of the property shall be made by the staff and the Planning Commission to assure compliance with all conditions of Planning Commission Resolution #3721. The operation shall be reviewed again May 14, 1981. Failure to maintain compliance with the conditions of the Planning Commission resolution, or any unacceptable situation caused by the operation of the business, should result in voiding the Conditional Use Permit. Full compliance with all conditions shall result in the Conditional Use Permit being made permanent with no further review necessary.
