**SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE TO CREATE A COMMUNITY CHOICE
AGGREGATION (CCA)**

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following ordinance:

**ORDINANCE NO. 4256 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
POMONA, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY A COMMUNITY
CHOICE AGGREGATION PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES
CODE**

DISCUSSION:

This ordinance was first introduced at the February 25, 2019, City Council Meeting (See Attachments No. 1 February 25, 2019, staff report and Attachment No. 2 Ordinance No. 4256). The purpose of proposed ordinance is to create a CCA to allow the City to purchase wholesale power on behalf of the City's customers and have that power distributed to the customers at a discount.

The ordinance will take effect 30 days after its adoption on March 4, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Based on the estimated revenues and expenditures it is estimated the City and its residents and business operators will save over \$35 million over a 10 year period.
