RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt of the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-19 – A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2018-19 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) BUDGET BY CLOSING COMPLETED/CANCELLED PROJECTS AND RE-APPROPRIATING \$206,975.61 IN UNEXPENDED FUNDS

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Public expectation, Council direction, and standard engineering practices require timely completion of projects. The completion/cancellation of these CIP projects enables the release of unexpended funds that may be used to: fund a new project; provide additional funding for a project which is currently partially funded; or return funding to original funding sources. The proposed action will result in the closing of thirteen completed/cancelled projects.

FISCAL IMPACT: The closing out of thirteen CIP Projects will release \$765,426.61 from various funding sources as listed in Exhibit A, Section 1 for future appropriations. Of this amount, \$206,975.61 will be re-appropriated to CIP Projects as listed in Exhibit A, Section 2.

PREVIOUS RELATED ACTION: On June 4, 2018, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-69 to approve the FY 2018-19 CIP Budget.

DISCUSSION: The following table itemizes the projects to be closed, the funding sources, and the unexpended amounts to be released from these completed/cancelled projects:

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* The table above includes \$86,460.61 of General Fund Carryover that staff is recommending to be reallocated into CIP Project 428-2590-XXXXX-67918 - Major Street Rehabilitation -2015 Metro Call. As part of the City Fiscal Sustainability Policy, one of the objectives is to dedicate funding to the Capital Improvement Program for Citywide improvements that are without an alternative funding source. The policy further states that at least 0.25% of the annual General Fund revenues were to be allocated to the City's operating budget beginning with Fiscal Year 2013-14, with the percentage set to increase by 0.10% each year until reaching 1.0%. For the past several fiscal years this objective to contribute to the CIP has been suspended via language in the respective adopted operating budget resolution, due to fiscal necessity. Alternatively, should the Council desire, the General Fund Carryover amount can be re-appropriated to the General Fund – Fund Balance, with the closeout of these CIP projects.
