SUBJECT: ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS

FOR STREET REHABILITATION AND AMENDING THE FY 2018-19 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) BUDGET BY RECEIVING AND APPROPRIATING A TOTAL OF \$545,155 FROM THE CITY OF CLAREMONT AND COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES FOR STREET REHABILITATION - DISTRICT 6, PROJECT NO. 428-2590-XXXXXX

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council take the following actions:

1) Adopt the following Resolutions:

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-30 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CLAREMONT FOR STREET REHABILITATION- DISTRICT 6, PROJECT NO. 428-2590-XXXXX-67921 AND AMENDING THE FY 2018-19 CIP BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING A \$233,675 CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROJECT FROM THE CITY OF CLAREMONT

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-31 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES FOR STREET REHABILITATION- DISTRICT 6, PROJECT NO. 428-2590-XXXXX-67921 AND AMENDING THE 2018-19 CIP BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING A \$311,480 CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROJECT FROM THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES

- 2) Find that the "Street Rehabilitation District 6," Project No. 428-2590-XXXXX-67921 is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301(c), in that the project consists of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing streets
- 3) Authorize the City Manager and/or Mayor to take all necessary actions needed by the City of Claremont, County of Los Angeles, and others to execute the cooperative agreements and related project funding documents on behalf of the City for Street Rehabilitation District 6, Project No. 428-2590-XXXXXX-67921

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Adoption of the Resolutions will approve Cooperative Agreements with the City of Claremont (Attachment 1) and the County of Los Angeles (Attachment 2) providing a total contribution of \$545,155 towards the rehabilitation of 0.75 miles of Towne Avenue, generally expected to proceed from Foothill Boulevard toward Bonita Avenue, as funds allow. This will include up to approximately 0.12 miles in the Los Angeles County jurisdiction and 0.5 miles of the northbound outer lane in the City of Claremont. Total contributions from the City of Claremont and Los Angeles County to this project are expected to fully fund improvement areas not within City boundaries to provide a smooth transition within their jurisdictions along Towne Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT: There will be no impact to the General Fund. The funds to be appropriated for this project are as follows:

PUBLIC NOTICING REQUIREMENTS: N/A

PREVIOUS RELATED ACTION: On November 6, 2017, City Council amended the FY 2017-18 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget by updating the project description for "Street Rehabilitation - District 6," Project No. 425-67921 and reappropriating excess RDA Bond proceeds (District 6) in the amount of \$2,240,285.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT: The "Street Rehabilitation - District 6," Project No. 428-2590-XXXXX-67921 is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301(c), in that the project consists of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing streets.

DISCUSSION: The Street Rehabilitation - District 6 project consists of major street pavement rehabilitation improvements and rehabilitation of ancillary areas (sidewalks, medians, etc.) at Towne Avenue from Foothill Boulevard to Bonita Avenue, as funds allow. Towne Avenue is a major north-south arterial through the City from Riverside Drive to the south, through pockets of City of Claremont and Los Angeles County, to the northerly limits of Pomona and beyond.

The Cooperative Agreement to fund pavement rehabilitation of the County portion of Towne Avenue between East Grove Street and Richbrook Drive was drafted by Los Angeles County and has been reviewed by the Interim City Attorney. The Cooperative Agreement to fund pavement rehabilitation of the City of Claremont portion between Harrison Avenue and Amador Street was drafted by the Interim City Attorney and has been reviewed by the City of Claremont. City Council approval of this item will secure a total of \$545,155 of funds, \$233,675 from the City of Claremont and \$311,480 from Los Angeles County, for Street Rehabilitation – District 6, Project No. 428-2590-XXXXXX-67921. An aerial map of Towne Avenue showing the limits for this project is shown in Attachment 3.

Design of this project is complete and is currently out for bidding. The City of Claremont and Los Angeles County funding contributions, along with the available City funds, will fully fund the limits of this project. Construction is expected to begin by summer 2019.
