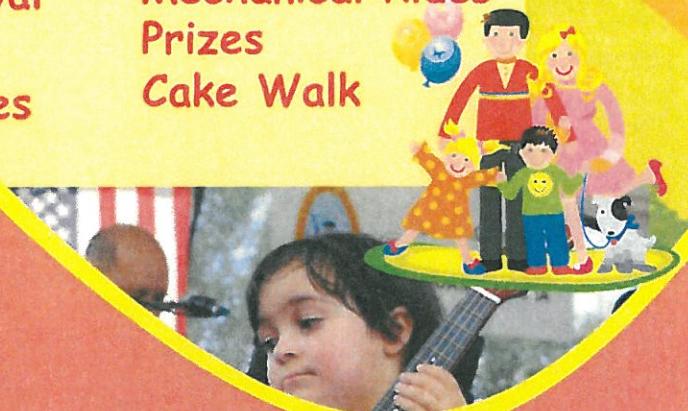

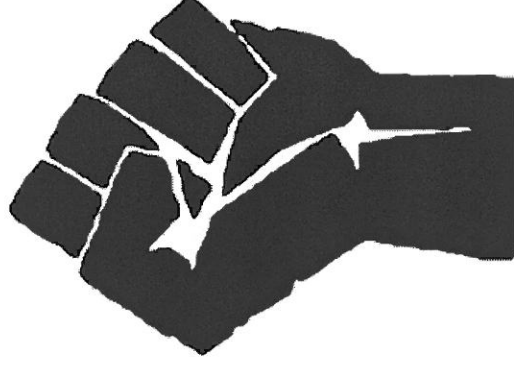



Re: Fee Waiver Application for Planning Department Fees

Dear City Council,

We are very happy to be making progress in establishing the ECOFARM in partnership with the City at the vacant lot on Buena Vista. Since granting unanimous City Council support, we have worked diligently with the community and city planning to develop a site plan that addresses the needs and concerns of the community. We have brought this plan to the planning department for feedback and incorporated all recommendations from the planning department. We feel we have satisfied all parties while remaining true to the food production, beautification, and community space creation objectives of the project.

Because the City Council wished to create a process for other community projects incorporating gardens, the City Council's final recommendation required us to obtain a determination of similarity. The determination of similarity fee is costly (\$816.33) and is not an item that we had planned for in our budget. Therefore, we would at this time like to make a formal written request to the City Council to waive the determination of similarity fee. We see no reasonable nexus between an almost thousand dollar fee and the decision to acknowledge that growing food in a neighborhood community is substantially similar to "raising crops" which is allowed in residential zones by right.

Our City's code does provide for the waiver of development fees, upon written request of the developer (in this case United Voices of Pomona for Environmental Justice, engaging in community development) to the City Council stating the absence of a reasonable relationship between the amount of the fee and the impact of the development.

We asked the planning department about obtaining an application for this fee waiver and there did not seem to be a form or process regularly in use allowing this code to be carried out. Nevertheless, we would like to request the waiving of this determination of similarity fee (\$816.33) and also our sign permit fee (\$120.33) in accordance with this statute. You can find the fee waiver reference in the city code in Subpart B--Land Development Ordinances, Chapter 70--Administration and Planning, Article III Development Fees and Dedications, Sec. 70-66 Waiver, Reduction, or Adjustment.

We have included the language of the code as an attachment for your reference. We do appreciate the City's help in making this project possible and for helping to pave the way for

other community projects of this nature in Pomona. We would like to suggest as a long-term consideration a policy which does not require small community organizations to request a determination of similarity, such as allowing the present finding, once obtained, to set precedent, or amending the allowed uses to include projects such as these by right or by application, accompanied with no more than a nominal fee.

Enclosure: Subpart B--Land Development Ordinances, Chapter 70--Administration and Planning, Article III Development Fees and Dedications, Sec. 70-66 Waiver, Reduction, or Adjustment

Sec. 70-66. - Waiver, reduction or adjustment.



A developer of any development project subject to the fees provided for in this article may apply to the city council for a reduction or adjustment to that fee or a waiver of that fee, based upon the absence of any reasonable relationship or nexus between the impacts of that development and either the amount of the fee charged or the type of facilities to be financed. The request shall be made in writing and filed with the city council. A building or public works permit shall not be issued until such time as the city council has rendered a decision upon the request. The request shall state in detail the factual basis for the claim of waiver, reduction or adjustment. The city council shall consider the request within 30 days after the filing of the fee adjustment application. If a reduction, adjustment or waiver is granted and approved by the city council, any change in use or size of the project shall invalidate the waiver, adjustment or reduction of the fee. This article shall not affect any development which has received final planning commission or city council approval.
