**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-63 – A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
POMONA, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF U.S. SENATE BILL 227 “SAVANNA’S ACT” AS
A CALL TO ACTION IN ADDRESSING MISSING AND MURDERED INDIGENOUS
WOMEN AND CHILDREN**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: At the May 20, 2019, Meeting, Councilmembers indicated their desire to place consideration of a resolution supporting the proposed federal legislation after hearing comments from several representatives from the City’s native American community.

At the May 20, 2019 Council Meeting, multiple speakers addressed the Council concerning the alarming rate of missing and murdered women and children within the Nation’s Native and Indigenous peoples communities.
