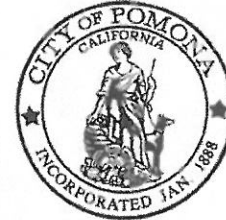

City Event: 2019 Summer Concerts in the Park
Amount: \$4,500

Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council:

The Community Services Division would like to thank the City Council for the opportunity to submit a Finding of Public Benefit request in the amount of \$4,500 to support Summer Concerts in the Park at Civic Center Plaza. Our goal is to enhance the quality of life, strengthen community, and act as a source of community pride to promote positive, safe activities in our parks through FREE and FAMILY FRIENDLY activities.

The City recently received a grant from the Los Angeles County Arts Commission in order to provide three free concerts that will take place on the third Saturdays of July, August and September 2019.

Funds for concerts are granted by Supervisorial District through a competitive application process through the Los Angeles County Arts Commission - LA County Free Summer Concerts grant program. Pomona's concerts are sponsored by Los Angeles County Supervisor Hilda Solis as each of the five Los Angeles County Supervisorial Board Offices provides funds to cover musician fees. The City will be responsible for implementation, logistics and promotion as well as some additional expenses. Staff will be working with the Mayor and Council to cover the additional expenses through sponsorships and/or through a finding of public benefit.

Staff are estimating costs to be roughly \$4,500 (\$1,500/concert) to cover portable restrooms, security and custodial resources associated with the concerts. The hope is that sponsors will be identified to cover these expenses; however, in the event that sponsorships do not completely cover the \$4,500, staff is submitting this finding of public benefit for the June 17, 2019 agenda. This will allow council the full 30 days to make contributions, which is in advance of the first concert on July 20, 2019.
