

## **CAC RESOLUTION NO. 2019-XX**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMONA ADOPTING SPECIFICATIONS (“EXHIBIT A”) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PLAQUES REQUIRED BY THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pomona is dedicated to preserving and building on the inventory of existing public art within the community;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council established the Art in Public Places Program (“AIPP”) that includes both a public art for private development component and a public acquisitions and donations component, codified as Section .5809-24—Public Art for Private Development in the Pomona Zoning Ordinance, and further adopted through the AIPP Policy and Guidelines Manual (“AIPP Manual”);

**WHEREAS**, the AIPP Manual requires identification of artwork with a plaque placed in a location near the artwork piece;

**WHEREAS**, the Cultural Arts Commission intends to provide consistency and predictability for artists in providing identification of artwork in the City of Pomona, and the proposed specifications for the installation of plaques meets this intent;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed specifications as shown in “Exhibit A” meet the guidelines set forth in the AIPP Manual and complies with Section .5809-24—Public Art Requirement for Private Development of the Pomona Zoning Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Cultural Arts Commission of the City of Pomona as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to the State Guidelines to Implement the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), this action as defined is Categorically Exempt, under Section 15301, Class 1 exemption for existing facilities, in that the future installation of plaques would only be located on an existing facility and involves minor alterations of an existing structure. Therefore, no further environmental review is required.

**SECTION 2.** If any part, provision, or section of this resolution is determined by a court or other legal authority with jurisdiction over the subject matter of this resolution to be unenforceable or invalid, the remainder of the entirety of this resolution shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this resolution are severable.

**SECTION 3.** Based on consideration of the whole record before it, the Cultural Arts Commission hereby finds that the action is in accordance with Section .5809-24—Public Art Requirement for Private Development and conforms to the guidelines of the AIPP Manual.

**SECTION 4.** The Cultural Arts Commission hereby approves the proposed specifications for the installation of plaques required by the Art in Public Places Program, as shown in “Exhibit A.”

**SECTION 5.** The Secretary shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and forward the original to the City Clerk.
