## Arborist Report — Construction Related

Species of Tree: *Quercus suber*

### Purpose:

There is an existing stump of a Cork Oak at the location mentioned above. In order to remove the stump, a permit must be obtained from the City of Pomona.

### Process:

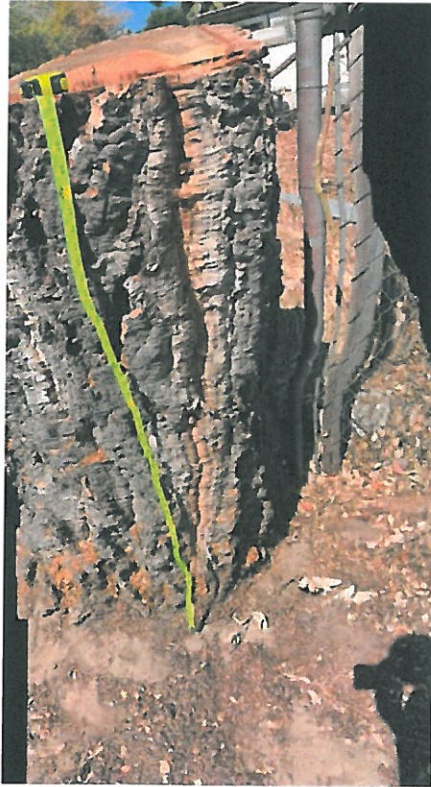
After discussing the history with the property owner, and reviewing photos and aerial imagery of the location, it was determined that a cork oak was removed from the location. There are remaining leaves on the ground around the existing stump, which are characteristic of a Cork Oak (see photo next page). As well, the bark of the tree is characteristic of a Cork Oak (see photo next page).

The stump of this tree, however, remains in place. This stump measures approximately 50" in height and 36" wide as seen in the photos below.
