

Project Description:

The intent of this contract is to enter into a Cooperative Agreement between the City of Pomona and the California Conservation Corps, Pomona Center. The intent of agreement will be focused on clearing v-ditch drains and corridors of debris, brush and other vegetation, potentially including dead or live trees, and general clearing of dead, overgrown or other unwanted vegetation for wildfire prevention purposes, in the Phillips Ranch Assessment District Area of the City of Pomona.

The BMP's (Best Management Practices) associated with the project are indicated below:

Primary/Initial Focus - V-Ditch Corridors

1. Remove and dispose of or process any soil/rock and other debris, and live or dead plant material, including dead or downed trees or branches, within v-ditch channels to the extent that the upper surface of the v-ditch channel is fully exposed.
2. Trim and remove all dead plant material, including dead or downed trees or branches, and all live plant material <3" in DBH, as close to flush with the ground as safely feasible to a distance of approximately 2' wide along each side of the exposed v-ditch surfaces. Work may extend beyond the minimum 2' width as practical.

Secondary Focus – Other Phillips Ranch areas as directed by the City Parks and Landscape Supervisor or Parks and Facilities Manager.

1. 0' to 8' of adjacent property lines –
 - a. Cut and dispose of all vegetation, including live trees <3" in DBH, as close to flush with the ground as safely feasible.
2. 8' to 100' of adjacent property lines –
 - a. Cut and dispose of all dead vegetation and trees, and all non-native understory vegetation and non-native trees <7", as close to flush with the ground as safely feasible.
 - b. Raise remaining living tree canopies to a minimum height of 6' above the ground
 - c. Trim all grasses and herbaceous weeds to <6" above the ground.
 - d. Trim native shrubs to a height not to exceed 18" above the ground and create 24" of horizontal space between individual plants.

General Guidelines

1. Methods of disposal or processing of soil/rock, other natural fine debris, and processed plant material, will be coordinated at each location with the City's Parks and Landscape Supervisor or Parks and Facilities Manager.
2. Subsurface structure should generally be left intact to mitigate potential erosion hazards.
3. If left on site, debris or mulch shall be leveled, spread, and lightly compacted to where it does not exceed 4" in depth above original grade and does not create a potential wildfire or debris flow hazard, and individual rocks larger than 8" in diameter shall either be relocated to level terrain or embedded to where they do not present a rolling hazard.
4. All non-naturally occurring debris/trash shall be removed from site and lawfully disposed of or recycled.
