ENGLISH TUDOR REVIVAL

1924



Built in 1924, this English Tudor Revival home displays the characteristic half-timbering with stucco infill and siding, steep gables and hipped roof on the main side-facing gable. The main front-projecting gable forms the entryway and courtyard. The front door is wooden and flanked by sidelights. Triple-set windows are also used throughout the front.

George W. Scully and his wife, Elizabeth, were the first owners. He was an auditor at Southern Service Co.
