Dear Mr. Dowling,

I performed a site visit to the above address on August 7, 2019. My assignment was to identify the species of a tree located in the backyard as part of a tree removal permit. The following is a summary of my observations with recommendations.

OBSERVATIONS

I observed one Quercus agrifolia, (Coast Live Oak) tree located in the backyard along the north fence line. This tree is in good health, a multi trunk DBH (Diameter at Breast Height) of 18" and 21", and stands 40-45' tall with a canopy spread of 30-40'. The trunk of the tree is growing against a Edison wood power pole and it is less than 3 feet from the north/east corner of the garage.

RECOMMENDATIONS/MITIGATION

The current location of the Quercus agrifolia tree is causing damage to the garage and growing into to the Edison power pole, I recommend removing this tree
