

## Historic Sites Tree Protection & Preservation Program – Recommended Amendments Summary

Program Items	Recommended Amendments
<b>1. Definitions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Add definitions section to Program</li> <li>• Condense and clean up Program so that all definitions are in one section</li> <li>• Define “Protected Species List” (PSL) to be all-inclusive and include mature trees, street trees, and specimen (heritage) trees</li> <li>• Character-defining landscaping is all trees in PSL within the Historic Districts</li> </ul>
<b>2. SEC Coordination for Line Clearing Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Notify Historic Preservation Committee (HPC) 10 days prior to scheduled trimmings</li> <li>• Work with Southern California Edison (SCE) to ensure that the City receives the annual tree trimming schedule in accordance with the Program</li> </ul>
<b>3. Removal of Character-Defining Landscaping</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minor Certificate of Appropriateness (MINCOA) required for all tree removals</li> <li>• Establish qualification criteria for MINCOA – 1) Danger to Public Welfare; 2) Dead or Diseased Trees</li> <li>• Tree trimmings no longer require MINCOA, unless trimmed beyond the City’s pruning guidelines</li> <li>• Retroactive MINCOA for unpermitted tree removals</li> </ul>
<b>4. Pruning and Trimming</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pruning and trimming consistent with ANSI A300 Standards do not require a permit</li> <li>• Any proposed pruning or trimming methods beyond adopted standards are subject to approval of a MINCOA</li> </ul>
<b>5. Replacement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All removed trees on PSL subject to tree replacement requirements</li> <li>• Permitted removals to use tree replacement ratio based on objective methodology to replace benefit loss of removed trees</li> <li>• Unpermitted removals use tree replacement ratio based on objective methodology to replace benefit loss of removed trees, multiplied by two</li> <li>• In-lieu fee may be paid as replacement</li> <li>• Replacement must be made within one year of approval</li> </ul>
<b>6. Appeal Process</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All MINCOA appealable to HPC by any interested parties</li> <li>• Decisions of the HPC appealable to the City Council</li> </ul>
