

Previous Related Council Actions

On April 4, 2016, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2016-36, authorizing Harris & Associates as the Engineer of Record and ordering the preparation of the Annual Engineer's Report for the 2016-17 Annual Assessment Levy for the Consolidated Citywide Street Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District.

On June 6, 2016, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2016-38 approving the Engineer's Report and declared the City's intention to annex additional territory, collect Assessments, and set the Public Hearing for July 11, 2016.

On July 11, 2016, City Council conducted a Public Hearing and adopted Resolution No. 2016-100 confirming the zone boundaries and Assessment Levy for the Assessment District for 2016-17.

On April 17, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution 2017-50, authorizing Harris & Associates as the Engineer of Record and ordering the preparation of the 2017-18 Annual Engineer's Report for the Annual Assessment Levy for the Consolidated Citywide Street Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District.

On March 19, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution 2018-22, authorizing Harris & Associates as the Engineer of Record and ordering the preparation of the Annual Engineer's Report for the 2018-19 Annual Assessment Levy for the Consolidated Citywide Street Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District.

On April 23, 2018, the City Council authorized the formation of the Phillips Ranch Assessment District Ad Hoc Committee.

On November 19, 2018, the City Council adopted a Resolution awarding a contract to NBS for assessment consulting services related to the Phillips Ranch Assessment District.

On February 4, 2019, the City Council adopted a resolution authorizing Harris and Associates and NBS Government Finance Group as the engineers of record for FY 2019-20 and ordering the preparation of the 2019-20 Engineer's Report for the annual assessment levy of the Citywide Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance Districts.
