Dear Ms. Butler:

Attached please find a Report from the Charter Review Commission, including the Proposed Amendments to the Pomona City Charter, submitted pursuant to Article XVII of the City Charter.

Please place the following ballot questions on the November \_\_\_\_\_ General Municipal Election ballot for consideration by the City of Pomona electorate:

(A) For the Local Primary Measure:

"Shall the City Charter be amended to establish a local primary election for the office of Mayor and City Councilmember to coincide with the Statewide Primary Election, beginning in the year 2022; whereby if a candidate secures majority voter approval in the local primary, he or she will be elected, and if no candidate secures majority voter approval, the top two candidates shall stand for a run-off election to coincide with the Statewide General Election?"	<b>YES</b>

(B) For the Term Limits Measure:

"Shall the City Charter be amended to enact a three-term lifetime limit on elected service in Pomona, whether serving as Mayor or as a Council Member?"	<b>YES</b>

(C) For the Independent Redistricting Commission Measure:

"Shall the City Charter be amended to create an independent citizens' redistricting commission of Pomona residents who shall determine the boundaries of City Council electoral districts every ten years or as needed after the United States Census in accordance with applicable Federal and State law?"	<b>YES</b>

(D) For the Charter Review Commission Measure:

"Shall the City Charter be amended to specify that the Pomona Charter Review Commission, every ten years, may review the City Charter over a two year period and, during that time, propose one or more charter amendments directly to the voters, with City Council input but not requiring City Council approval; and also to clarify the procedures by which charter amendments may be proposed by the Commission?"	<b>YES</b>
