EXHIBIT A PROGRAM SCOPE +BUDGET

TEMPORARY ART PILOT PROGRAM

TAPP No. 1: "A-RAILS"

- 1. Provide "public artwork" either permanent or temporary in nature on "permanent displays." Permanent displays to be used include K-Rails and City-owned public utility boxes. Finished products may be referred to as an "A-Rail." The A-Rail must remain a permanent display of public artwork and will be owned and maintained by the City of Pomona.
- 2. Local Pomona-based artists are preferred for the execution of the public artwork. All attempts should be made to solicit Pomona-based artists and non-profit organizations identified on the City's Artist Shortlist prior to seeking other artists.
- 3. Multiple artists and organizations should be involved in the execution of the public artwork, and A-Rails should be deployed Citywide on an as-needed basis through the Activate Pomona Pilot Program.
- 4. The Pomona community, including youth and local businesses impacted by the A-Rails, should be consulted for opinions on theme and content of the proposed public artwork.
- 5. The budget associated with this program includes a \$20/square foot cost for the public artwork, along with up to 20% stipend to any qualified non-profit organization selected to completed the scope.
- 6. Any proposed public artwork must be submitted by the Planning Division to the Cultural Arts Commission and its Citizens Advisory Committee for a 48-hour review period. Upon conclusion of this period, if no individuals have asked for a special meeting to discuss the proposed artwork, the Planning Division may issue approval.
