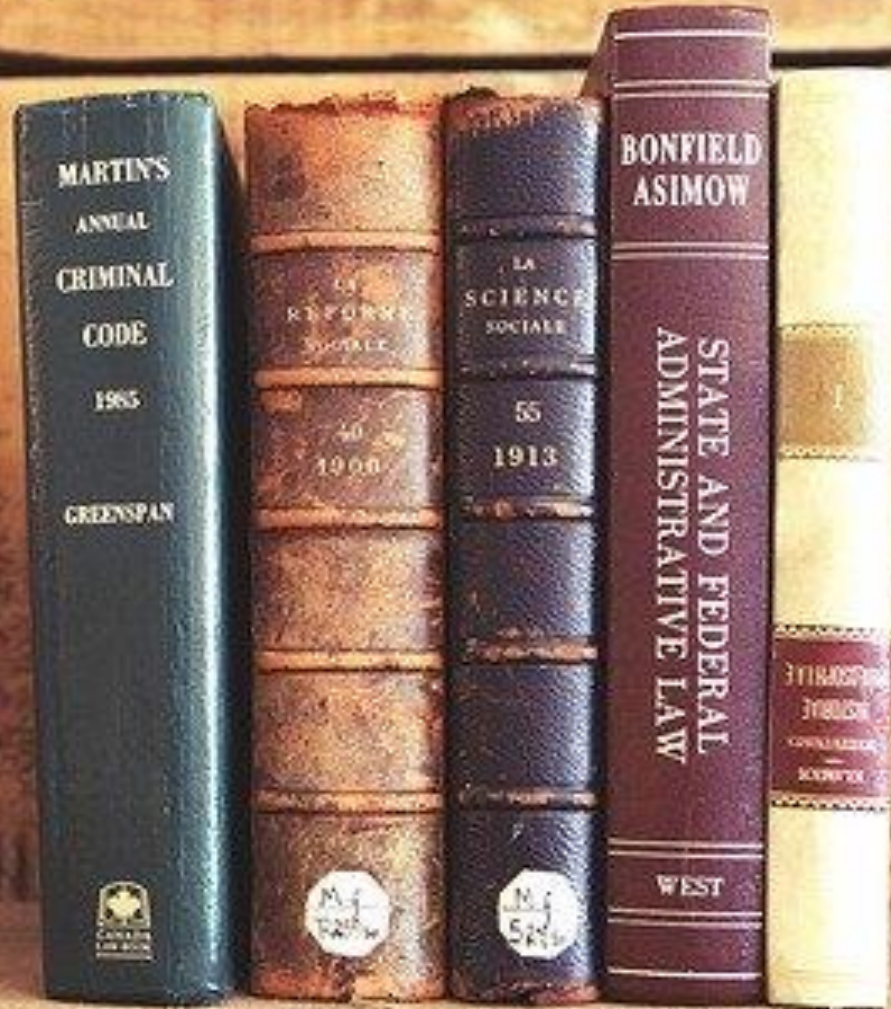

- Sustainability

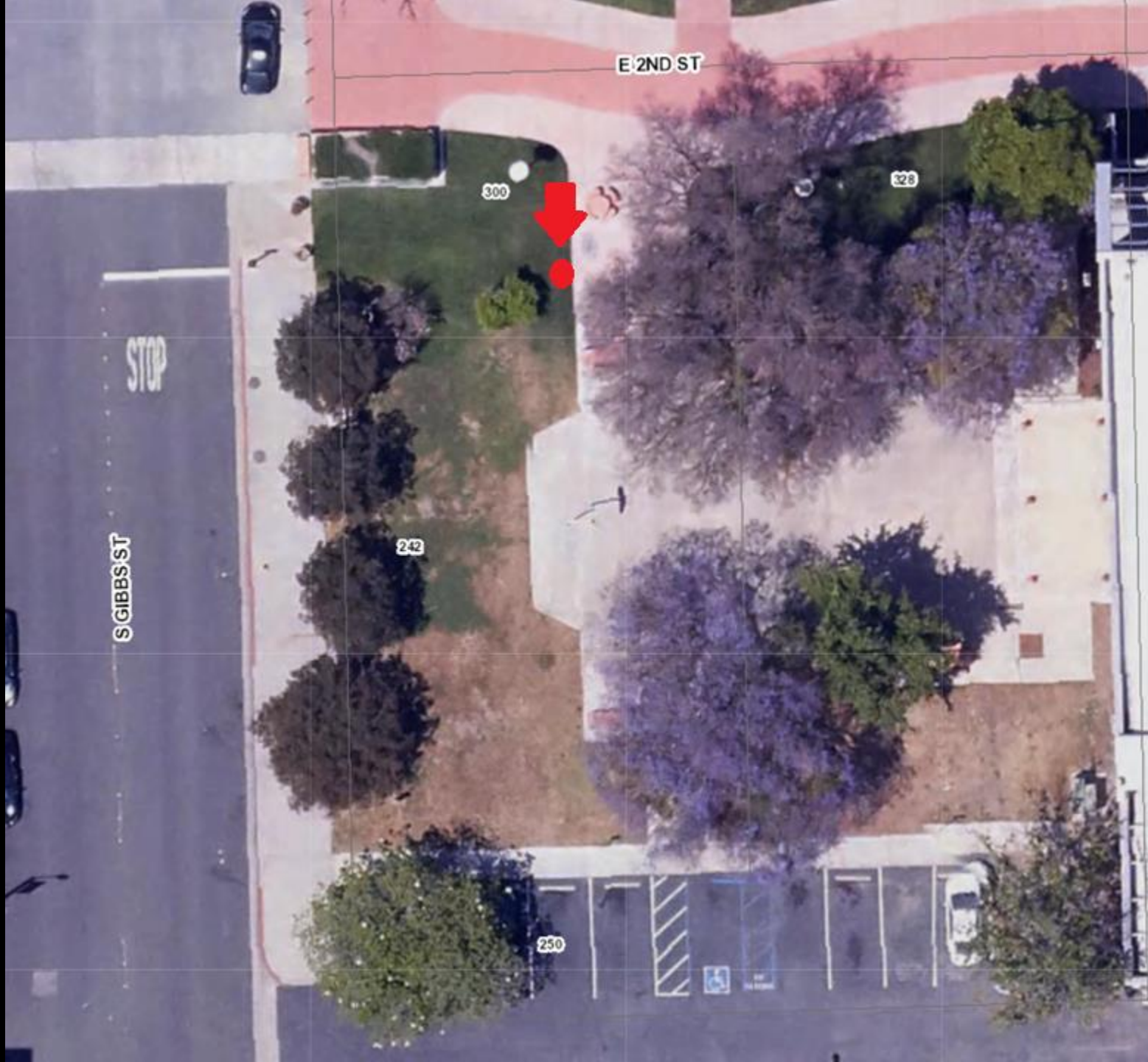


Centennial Park

242 S. Gibbs St.

- City staff conducted a site visit with the applicant on Aug. 5, 2020 to evaluate locations
- The proposed location is on a pathway in the north area of the park near the nexus with the Western University of Health Sciences
- Public Works has verified no interference with subsurface infrastructure
- The structure will meet the approved design guidelines for a free community library
- The steward will be Gente Organizada



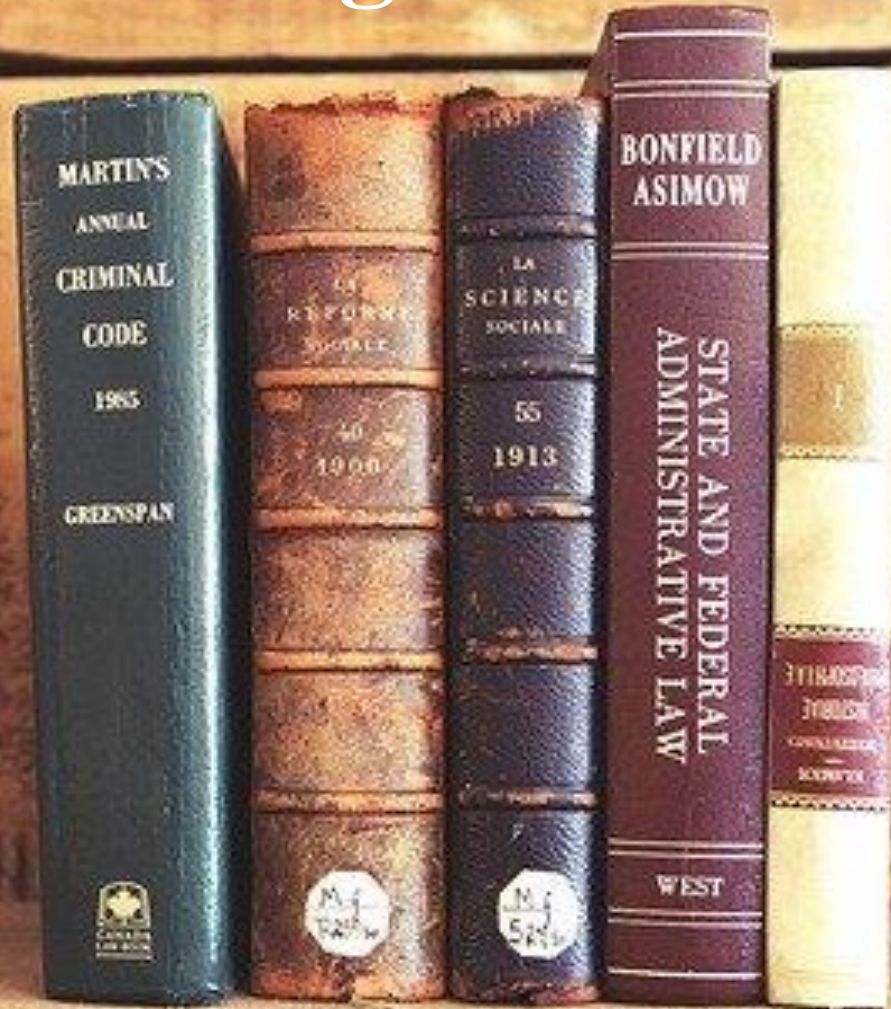




Martin Luther King Jr. Park

800 W. Lexington Ave.

- City staff conducted a site visit with the applicant on Sept. 2, 2020 to evaluate locations
- The proposed location is on the sidewalk immediately adjacent to the ADA ramp in the parking lot, in front of the gazebo
- The structure will meet the approved design guidelines for a free community library
- The steward will be Just Us 4 Youth
