## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-136**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE CONSOLIDATED PLAN, THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2020-2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AND THE FY 2020-21 CITY OPERATING BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATING HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME), COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION AND HEALTHY HOMES (LHRHH), CALHOME RE-USE FUNDS AND SECTION 8 HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER FUNDS, AND BY REALLOCATING BUDGETED EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT- CORONA VIRUS (CV) AND CDBG- CV PROGRAM FUNDS

**WHEREAS**, Section 1008 of the Pomona City Charter allows encumbered funds to be carried to the next fiscal year, subject to approval by City Council Resolution;

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council to amend the FY 2020-21 Adopted Operating Budget for various grant funds;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council must approve substantial amendments to the Federal Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan, the re-appropriation of HOME, CDBG, CDBG-CV, ESG-CV, Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes, CalHome Program Re-use Account, Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program, Tri-City Mental Health Center and Housing Authority Admin funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council must find that under the Federal guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the proposed changes are eligible uses of HOME, CDBG, Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes, CalHome Re-use and Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher funds and will serve low- to moderate-income persons and/or areas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. That on September 21, 2020, the City Council approved the proposed amendments to the City's Consolidated Plan, Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan and FY 2020-21 City Operating Budget increasing revenue estimates and appropriations to the HOME Program, Community Development Block Grant Program, CDBG-CV, ESG-CV, Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes Program, CalHome Program Re-use Account and Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher funds.

**SECTION 2**. The adopted FY 2020-21 City operating budget is hereby amended to reflect changes to revenue estimates and appropriations, as follows:
