## **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following ordinance:

## ORDINANCE NO. 4293 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, ADDING SECTION 34-222 TO ARTICLE V CHAPTER 34 OF THE POMONA MUNICIPAL CODE PROHIBITING THE HOURLY RENTALS OF HOTELS AND MOTELS WITHIN CITY LIMITS

## **DISCUSSION:**

The ordinance was first introduced at the October 19, 2020 City Council Meeting (Attachment No.1). The proposed Ordinance No. 4293 (Attachment No. 2) would enact an hourly rental ban for any hotels, motels, or lodging establishments within City limits in an effort to combat their use for Human Trafficking and related criminal activity.

The ordinance will take effect 30 days after its adoption on November 16, 2020.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:
