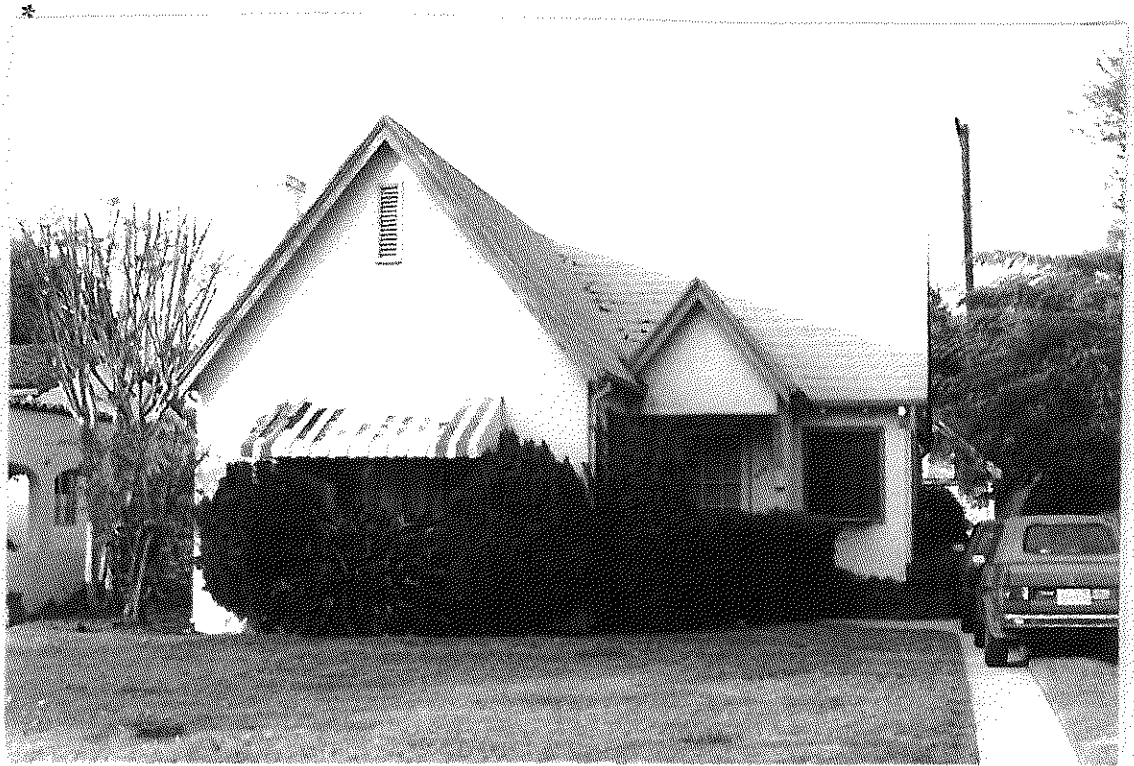


PERIOD REVIVAL

1925



A steeply-pitched gabled roof, typical of the Period Revival style, caps this single-storied ell-shaped house located at 219 Garfield Ave. The entry is covered by another smaller gabled roofed porch. The house is stucco-clad with a matching stucco-clad chimney on the outer west wall. The multi-paned front door has casement windows on either side.

The earliest recorded owners, musician William L. Cooper, and his wife, Jessie, took out a permit in August of 1926 to add a sunroom. The original building permit is missing. The house was later sold to Dr. J. G. Rea on June 20, 1932. A den was added in 1938.
