WHAT IS YOUR UNDERSTANDING of the objectives and goals of the Commission to which you are seeking appointment?

My understanding is that the Board of Parking Place Commissioners is the board that oversees and operates the downtown Vehicle Parking District. The commission regulates and enforces 35 parking lots within the downtown area. Within it's capacity, I believe the board should also aim to create a downtown experience that it is enjoyable to residents, local businesses, workers, and visitors so that they are encouraged to return to the downtown area for business, lesiure, or to reside.

Specifically, I also understand is that the commission is responsible for ratifying the sales of different types of parking permits from residential, to commuter, to employee permits, and 24 hour permits. It votes on different types of projects such as agreements with the DPOA to provide security patrols to specific lots, the purchase of security equipment such as cameras or blue emergency poles, the approval of parking signage and it reviews and considers amendments to parking policies and fees, reviews consultant and staff reports related to the possible acquisition and/or development of parking structures. It also votes on the sale of lots and reviews and votes on applications for the waiving of lot fees for use by community groups, etc.

BRIEFLY EXPLAIN what in your background, training, education or interests, you feel qualifies you for this appointment.

My previous experience on other city commissions gives me a good understanding on the procedural role that commissions have in the city decision making process, on how the Brown Act is used to run commission meetings, and how commission meetings provide a space for public input and participation into local governance.

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My analysis and esearch skills will help me study issues or projects as they can affect the VPD and downtown Pomona. Also my experience on the Planning Commission and college cousework on sociology and public administration give me a broader understanding of how regional topics (such as transporation and development) can affect the parking needs in Pomona.
