SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID FOR CITYWIDE AS-NEEDED CONCRETE REPAIR

SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council take the following actions:

- 1) Award a bid to G.M. Sager Construction Company, Inc. (G.M. Sager) at the prices bid, for a term of three (3) years with two (2), optional, one-year extensions for Citywide asneeded concrete repair services; and
- 2) Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to approve the agreement, purchase orders, and any extensions thereto, on behalf of the City.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Award of this bid will ensure that the City will be able to continue Citywide as-needed concrete repair services.

FISCAL IMPACT: The average annual estimated cost of concrete repair services is approximately \$210,000, and is funded from Gas Tax (SB1) fund (206-2520-52285), Measure M fund (138-2520-52285), and Transportation Development Act (TDA) fund (272-2506-52285). Funding for future years will be included in each respective annual budget submission.

PUBLIC NOTICING REQUIREMENTS: In accordance with Section 2-993.1(4) of the City's Purchasing Ordinance, a public notice inviting bids was posted on PlanetBids on November 25, 2020.

PREVIOUS RELATED ACTION: None.

DISCUSSION: On November 25, 2020, Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 2020-44 "AS NEEDED CONCRETE REPAIR" was issued on the City's electronic bidding platform. The solicitation notified 114 potential vendors, of which 20 bidders downloaded the IFB, resulting in the City receiving three (3) proposals. The three companies that submitted proposals were: 1) G.M. Sager Construction Company, Inc., 2) CT&T Concrete Paving, Inc., and 3) FS Contractors, Inc. (Attachment No. 1). All three proposals met the qualifications and were evaluated based on price.

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G.M. Sager was selected as the lowest responsible bidder. The City lacks the necessary equipment and staffing to resolve all of the service requests for sidewalks and curb and gutter repairs, necessitating a concrete contractor to be on-call. Award of this bid will ensure that the City will be able to continue as-needed concrete pavement repair services Citywide.
