## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-67**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CITY'S STREET PROJECTS LISTS, WITH CORRESPONDING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) AND RELATED PUBLIC WORKS OPERATIONAL ITEM LIST PLAN, TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (CTC) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 RMRA/SB-1 FUNDING

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB-1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB-1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, will receive an estimated \$2,974,080 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2021-22 from SB-1; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the fifth consecutive year in which the City is receiving SB-1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB-1; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

**WHEREAS,** the City used a Pavement Management Program to develop the SB-1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

**WHEREAS,** the funding from SB-1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate 29 streets/roads, and active transportation infrastructure throughout the City this year and of similar projects into the future; and

**WHEREAS,** the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in an at-risk condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into an at-risk condition; and

Resolution No. 2021-67 June 7, 2021 Page 1 of 3 WHEREAS, the SB-1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona, California as follows:

**<u>SECTION 1.</u>** The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council hereby approves submittal of the FY 2021-22 Public Works Operational Program Plan as shown on EXHIBIT "A-1" to be submitted to the CTC for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council hereby approves submittal of the RMRA/SB-1 Streets Lists for FY 2020-21 submittal to the CTC as shown in EXHIBIT "A-2" for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of Pomona is affirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these streets with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues. The streets list is part of "Street Preservation – Local (FY 20-21)," Project No. 428-2590-XXXXX-68562.

**SECTION 4.** The City Council hereby approves submittal of the RMRA/SB-1 Streets Lists for FY 2021-22 submittal to the CTC as shown in EXHIBIT "A-3" for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding. The streets list is part of "Street Preservation – Local (FY 21-22)," Project No. 428-2590-XXXXX-68572.

**SECTION 4.** The City Council hereby approves submittal of the RMRA/SB-1 Streets Lists for FY 2022-23 submittal to the CTC as shown in EXHIBIT "A-4" for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding.

**SECTION 5.** The City Council hereby approves submittal of the RMRA/SB-1 Streets Lists for FY 2021-22 submittal to the CTC as shown in EXHIBIT "A-5" for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of Pomona is affirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these streets with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues. The streets list is part of "Major Street Rehabilitation – 2015 Metro Call," Project No. 428-2590-XXXXX-67918.

**<u>SECTION 6.</u>** The City Council hereby approves the FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 Streets lists mapped on EXHIBIT "A-6" for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding.

**SECTION 7.** The City Council approves of Staff informing the CTC that the City of Pomona's Pavement Management System overall/average network 2019 (current) Pavement Condition Index (PCI) is 68.1.

**SECTION 8.** The City Council is hereby authorized to execute all documents required for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 including annual reporting forms, and any documents that may be required by legislative funding guidelines.
