RESOLUTION NO. 2021-166

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE POMONA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (PUSD) FOR A POMONA RESOURCE OFFICER (PRO) PROGRAM FROM NOVEMBER 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023, AND AMENDING THE FY 2021-22 OPERATIONAL BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES BY \$194,438 AND APPROPRIATIONS BY \$259,251

WHEREAS, the Pomona Police Department and Pomona Unified School District (PUSD) have an extensive history of working on partnerships projects that benefit youths and the community;

WHEREAS, part of these partnerships projects include school truancy, parenting skills and after-school youth programs at elementary, middle and high school campuses;

WHEREAS, the Pomona Police Department will unfreeze two (2) frozen Police Office positions to fulfill the contractual agreement;

WHEREAS, the Pomona Police Department and PUSD have developed an Agreement that will fund (2) Police Officer positions to fund the PRO program from November 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023 of which PUSD will pay for (2) Police Officer positions, for a total reimbursement amount of \$491,563; the City has agreed to pay 25% of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby approves entering into an agreement with PUSD to fund the PRO program.

SECTION 2. That the City Council hereby unfreezes two (2) frozen Police Officer Positions.

SECTION 3. That the City Council hereby amends the FY 2021-22 operational budget by increasing revenue estimates by \$194,438 and appropriations by \$259,251.

SECTION 4. That City Clerk shall attest to and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
