## <u>Major Certificate of Appropriateness (MAJCOA 7490-2017)</u> PROJECT ADDRESS: 148 N. Huntington Street PROJECT APPLICANT: City of Pomona, Water Resources Department PROJECT PLANNER: Jeff Hamilton, Planning Consultant COUNCIL DISTRICT: CC District No. 1 <u>PROJECT DESCRIPTION:</u> Major Certificate of Appropriateness to allow the demolition of three (3) structures with estimated construction dates between the 1890s - 1940s. Pursuant to the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an Initial Study and a Mitigated Negative Declaration were prepared consistent with CEQA Section 15070 to assess the potential effects of this project on the environment. The
