RESOLUTION NO. 2026-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 OPERATING BUDGET BY ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$750, INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES TO FD101 GENERAL FUND-CC4112 AFTERSCHOOL-45000 DONATIONS AND APPROPRIATING \$750 OF DONATED FUNDS TO FD101 GENERAL FUND-CC4112 AFTER SCHOOL-52000 ACTIVITY PROGRAM SUPPLIES FOR THE HEROES OF POMONA PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Heroes of Pomona Speech Contest was designed to provide 100 or more participants in the After School Recreation Program with meaningful opportunities to develop valuable communication and public speaking skills; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2025-26 Operating Budget is amended by accepting a cash donation of \$750 and increasing revenue estimates to provide the cash scholarship prizes to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners of the Heroes of Pomona Speech Contest.

WHEREAS, the donation of \$750 will be appropriated to the After School Program to be utilized to award the cash scholarship prizes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council amends the FY 2026-26 Operating Budget by accepting a donation, increasing revenue estimates (FD101 General Fund-CC4112 After School-45000 Other Revenue-Donations) and appropriating \$750 of donated funds to the After School Program (FD101 General Fund-CC4112 After School-52000 Controllable Expenses-Activity Program Supplies).

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
