

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2026-27 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) BUDGET, INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATING \$11,623,000 OF STATE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (ATP) GRANT FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE “BIKE PATH – SAN JOSE CREEK,” FD428 CIP PROJECT FUND | CC2590 CIP | PROJECT NO. 58072

WHEREAS, the City Council is prescribed the authority by Charter of the City of Pomona to adopt and amend the CIP budgets; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the FY 2026-27 CIP Budget to increase revenue estimates and appropriate \$11,623,000 in funding for the construction of the “Bike Path – San Jose Creek” Project No. FD428 CIP Project Fund | CC2590 CIP | Project No. 58072; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide sufficient funding to successfully complete this Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona, California as follows:

SECTION 1. In compliance with Section 15070 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines, an Initial Study was prepared to assess the potential effects of this project on the environment. The City Council, exercising their independent judgment, has reviewed the Initial Study and determined that although the proposed project could have a significant effect on the environment, the effects will be reduced to a level that is less than significant with the implementation of mitigation measures outlined in the Mitigated Negative Declaration.

SECTION 2. The City Council amends the FY 2026-27 CIP Budget by increasing RC180 State Grant revenue estimates and appropriating \$11,623,000 of ATP grant funding to the “Bike Path – San Jose Creek,” FD428 CIP Project Fund | CC2590 CIP | Project No. 58072.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
